- Approval of January 2017 meeting minutes – Previously approved and uploaded to the SFV ACTS Website

Director's Report:

Ofelia Ruiz

- 35 team members are serving on this year's Woman's Retreat – including leadership team
- Four planning meetings have been held
- All meetings take place at the Father Simon Center but this location is not available on February 10 and March 10. The February 10th meeting will take place at Ofelia's house.
 - Cece to look into procuring alternate locations for these two dates
- Ofelia shared the team list with Core
- The team is planning on holding a fundraiser at Applebee's Restaurant in Northridge in order to subsidize some of the retreat expenses and offer some partial scholarships.
- At this point Applebee's management have offered two dates that are open to hold the fundraiser: April 8 or April 22
 - The goal is to sell 100 tickets at @10.00 per ticket for a buffet-style breakfast
 - 50% of sales would go to support the Woman's ACTS Retreat
 - Ofelia expects to receive confirmation about one of the two dates within a week.
 - Each team member will be asked to sell a minimum number of tickets
 - *(Ofelia was reminded that funds raised through any fundraiser must go through ACTS and that the tickets must specify that \$5.00 of the \$10.00 sale will be going to ACTS. Additionally she was informed that we now have access to the 501C through Santa Rosa.)*
- Ofelia reported she had purchased string for rosaries, journals and other supplies. She will be submitting some receipts for reimbursement at the next Core meeting.
- Bought journals
- Thus far she has collected 8 applications for the retreat along with required deposits
- She has received some scholarship requests and these will be presented to Father for approval
- She will be calling the tri-parishes to arrange dates for pulpit talks

- Ofelia presented Core with copies of the Retreat Registration form
- It was reported that the mini retreat will take place at Bea Ruli's house
- Francisco reported he will be providing samples of shirts for those sisters who need to order.

- She is still seeking out someone to lead the gathering after the Return Mass

Lydia provided updates:

- She has spoken with members from "JAM", "The Upper Room", "Fishers of Men", Mario Murillo's "Alpha Omega" ministries, "OREMOUS", and "Living Waters", and they are all willing to meet with father Juan about keeping with the format of the Small Faith Communities and the Catholic faith.
- Wants Ricky Jones to provide training before he moves to Utah by the end of March and reported that Ricky feels the training can be carried out in one session.
- She would like to reach out to two of the most recent past Directors (Jose & Helen) about providing training to the table leaders and other team members so they can reach out to retreatants establish Small Faith Communities as prescribed by ACTS Missions.
